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CHILD CARE PROGRAMS

NAME: Community Child Care Solutions

ABOUT: Community Child Care Solutions serves as the child care resource for families, child care professionals, and the community in Somerset and Middlesex counties.

PROGRAMS:

CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (CCAP)

WHAT IT DOES: A program that helps low-income working parents and students afford childcare.

ELIGIBILITY:

PARENT/APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a County resident.
- Work part time AND go to school/training part time.
- Must be working full-time (30 hours weekly or more), attending school full-time (12 credits or more), or in job training (20 hours weekly or more)
- Must meet income eligibility guidelines.

CHILD/CHILDREN ELIGIBILITY

- Children up to age 13, or less than the age of 19 incapable of self-care.
- The child or children must be legally present in the US and have a valid Social Security number.
- A child under the NJ Division of Child Protection and Permanency's protective supervision is also eligible.

SUBMISSION INSTRUCTION

Applying for a Child Care Subsidy

- Proof of Income (pay stubs, tax returns, employer letter, etc.)
- School/Training Hours (class schedule, enrollment verification, etc.)
- Household Size (birth certificates, lease agreement, SNAP/TANF documentation, etc.)
- All Required Documents must be submitted to be considered for a subsidy.

WORK FIRST NEW JERSEY – CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE

WHAT IT DOES: A program that helps parents transition from welfare to work by offering child care subsidies through Work First New Jersey. While they provide referrals, they do not endorse specific providers and recommend visiting and interviewing options before making a choice.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Determined by the County Board of Social Services or the Department of Labor.
- Assigned by a Career Development Counselor or Income Maintenance Worker.
- Community Child Care Solutions will contact you after receiving a referral.
- Once employed, participants can receive subsidized child care for up to two years after case closure.

KINSHIP NAVIGATOR PROGRAM

WHAT IT DOES: A program that helps relatives raising children by providing child care subsidies, financial assistance, and support services.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Must prove they are a relative or legal guardian.
- Children must live with them.
- Caregivers under 60 who aren't working must show proof of disability.
- Financial eligibility is based on age, family size, and income.

CHILD CARE PROGRAM LISTS

WHAT IT DOES: A Child Care Checklist is a tool used to evaluate and ensure that a childcare facility meets quality standards, safety regulations, and developmental needs for children.

It typically includes key areas such as:

- Health & Safety – Cleanliness, sanitation, childproofing, and emergency preparedness.
- Staff Qualifications & Ratios – Proper training, background checks, and appropriate staff-to-child ratios.
- Curriculum & Activities – Age-appropriate learning, playtime, and social-emotional development.
- Facility & Environment – Safe, stimulating, and child-friendly spaces, both indoors and outdoors.
- Policies & Procedures – Clear guidelines on discipline, communication, illness, and emergencies.

CHARACTERISTICS OF QUALITY CARE

WHAT IT DOES: Outlines the essential characteristics of quality care for infants and school-aged children, including caregiver responsibilities, environmental standards, and program structures. It details the following:

1. **Infant Care** – Describes the role of caregivers in ensuring developmental support, emotional warmth, and structured routines. It also highlights the importance of a safe and engaging environment.
2. **School-Aged Child Care** – Focuses on fostering independence, providing academic and social support, and maintaining a structured yet flexible environment.
3. **Emergency Preparedness** – Covers key safety measures such as emergency drills, CPR training, evacuation plans, and communication strategies to ensure children's safety in various situations.

The document serves as a guideline for caregivers, parents, and childcare providers to ensure high-quality, safe, and developmentally appropriate care for children.
